5/7/2020	attempted kidnapping	1	A pregnant Cuban asylum seeker returned to Ciudad Juarez by DHS under MPP was nearly kidnapped in late February 2020, as she was walking to a bus station near her home. She fought off the kidnapers, leaving her bruised. Despite a police report and evidence of her injuries she did not pass the MPP Mexico fear screening in early March after a hearing in El Paso. 5/7/2020	kidnapping, assault	1	A Honduran asylum seeker who had been returned to Ciudad Juarez under MPP was kidnapped in April 2020 and his finger cut off when his family could not pay the kidnapers quickly enough.
